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# Preface

On behalf of the organizing committee, I am pleased to present the proceedings containing selected, peer reviewed papers from the 8th Annual International Conference on Cognitive - Social, and Behavioural Sciences (icCSBs 2019) Russia which was held in December 09-11, 2019, in Moscow, Russia.

The objective of the conference was to provide a forum for the discussion of the latest research connected with the cognitive, social and behavioral sciences.

The conference comprised covered thematic sections on Education and Pedagogy, Social Sciences, and Psychology.

The Academic Institute Conference Management System was used as a Conference Management System. The number of full papers accepted and presented were 48. Each author was allotted 15 minutes to present their paper.

The review process for the papers was stringent. The software program iThenticate was used for plagiarism detection. Each submission was subjected to a double-blind review process by two reviewers. The number of submissions received and reviewed was 65 and 59 respectively while the number of submissions accepted was 48 indicating an acceptance rate of 81%. A total of 15 reviewers were involved in the review process and 9 external reviewers included.
