# Preface

The volume contains selected, peer-reviewed papers from II International Scientific and Practical Conference "Individual and Society in the Modern Geopolitical Environment" which was held in May 25-30, 2020, in Volgograd State University and Sevastopol State University, Volgograd, Russia. ISMGE'20 was a climax event finalizing the annual spring scientific session at Volgograd State University.

The objective of conference concluded in providing an interdisciplinary forum for researchers, practitioners and scholars to present and discuss the most recent innovations and developments in the field of new cognitive technologies, international education and ICT applied to humanitarian research, state educational policy and economics, social law and ethics enforcement, tourism and ecology of the city, creation of friendly environment for students and people with special needs. The research papers also covered social inclusion, financial issues of sustainable development, city culture, globalization, digital media, thus every topic is obviously bound to individual and society. The 2nd International Scientific and Practical Conference "Individual and Society in the Modern Geopolitical Environment" (ISMGE 2020) mostly focused on the individual and society and their political, social, cultural, historic, technological and environmental ties.

ISMGE'20 was unique and important in a number of ways. Firstly, participants from 11 time zones were able to gather in one room and present their scientific achievements and research results mainly in the online format due to restrictive pandemic-prevention measures. Secondly, this event facilitated cooperation between like-minded people from different countries, who were involved in solving the challenges to develop the individual in various aspects, improve his/her social being, study societal issues. Thirdly, the level of the presented developments was really high since the significance of the presented materials was confirmed by the support of various international funds.

An essential attention was drawn to psychological and educational problems of personality development, an impact of patriotic education on individual development, principles and methods of socialization within global information society, the key aspects in training professionals demanded by the Russian and world economies.

The uniting link of the conference issues under discussion was consideration and comprehension of modern achievements in humanities and social sciences towards the innovation trajectory of modern society development and practical application of scientific-research projects in world practices.

The conference itinerary comprised welcoming and keynote speeches in a plenary session, and workshops which covered thematic sections on Identity, education and development; Identity, culture and communication; Tourism, international and cultural exchange; and Law, economics and society.

118 papers were accepted, and 128 papers were presented at the conference. About 250 people in total took part in the conference. Due to pandemic restrictions and Zoom room capacity participants were grouped into sections though it did not prevent them from fruitful discussion. Each author was allotted 7-15 minutes to present the paper and about 5-15 minutes to discuss. The conference's international flavour was provided by participants from Bulgaria, Africa, USA, China, France, Italy.

A research contest was held among young scientists. The first prize was given to Anna Koksharova, student of Ural State Economic University, work "Development of criteria for an adaptive organizational and pedagogical system of additional professional education for TASED"; Alesya Gavrish, master of education, postgraduate student, Paramonova Daria Valerievna, master of education, teacher, Moscow City Pedagogical University, Irina Sporova, master student, teacher of English, Volgograd State Social and Pedagogical University, Lyceum No. 8 Olympia, work "Contemporary political media discourse: the phenomenon of ritualization".

The review process for the papers was stringent. The software program iThenticate was used for plagiarism detection. The reviewers also referred to plagramme.com and plagiarisma.net. Each submission was subjected to a double-blind review process by two reviewers. The number of submissions received and reviewed

was 172 and the number of submissions accepted was 118 indicating an acceptance rate of 66.3%. A total of 15 reviewers were involved in the review process.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> International Scientific and Practical Conference "Individual and Society in the Modern Geopolitical Environment" – ISMGE 2020 was hosted by Volgograd State University and Sevastopol State University, Volgograd and Sevastopol, Russia, and supported by University of Zagreb, University of Timisoara, Scientific and Educational Institute of Professional International Communication (SEI PIC), Scientific Publishing Center "Open Knowledge" (Otkrytoe znanie), Scientific journal "Artium Magister". The conference chair and co-chairs express their sincere appreciation to all the organizing institutions, presenters, session chairs, members of the organizing committee, scientific committee, and peer review committee.
